



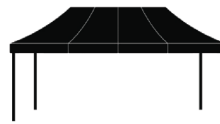

Shower House



Each unit will be assigned a number of specific shower stalls based on the number of attending Scouts. Each unit will have a unique code to unlock their shower stall.



Dining

FSSR will be renting large tents that will be situated around the dining hall to ensure ample distance between campers who are dining.

Mask Policy



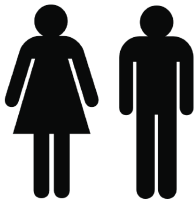
Cloth or surgical masks must be worn when indoors or when Scouts cannot spread out. Masks must be worn in the trading post and it will have an occupancy limit.



Unit Camping

Units will provide their own tents in order to reduce the chance of anything spreading between weekly sessions. The Ohio River Valley Council recommends that Scouts camp one per tent.

Contact Tracing



Merit Badge instructors will create and use seating charts whenever classroom-style instruction is held in order to contact trace, if need be.

Camper Capacity

Each summer camp session will be capped at 225 campers. This is to ensure a summer camp experience that is as safe and normal as possible.

Closed-Toe Shoes



Any person at Fort Steuben Scout Reservation should be wearing closed-toe shoes while navigating camp. Campers should change out of open-toed shoes when leaving the Waterfront or shower house.
